Cushions and backrests in moulded fire-retardant polyurethane foam with protective water-resistant and breathable fabric layer and finished with UV stable outdoor fabric. Tops in HPL Fenix® 10 mm. All metal parts are powder coated. Water-resistant protective covers are available.

Plastic materials, even if intended for outdoor use, may still be attacked over time by particular atmospheric pollutants (e.g. acid rain, high concentration of PM10, nitrogen oxides, hydrocarbons, etc.). Any changes in the surface and in colours may therefore occur under particular conditions of exposure and cannot be considered grounds for any claims.

Do not use detergents containing bleach, hydrochloric acid or products containing chloride on any metal parts. Salt, limescale or acid (from coffee, wine, orange juice, tomato juice, lemon, etc.) may discolour stainless steel parts if they are not promptly cleaned. Products or parts made of stainless steel used near the sea or in interior fittings of swimming pools require more frequent cleaning to remove chloride deposits and prevent corrosion and chemical attack of the external surface. Stains on stainless steel surfaces must be promptly cleaned. If left for a long time they can become permanent.

Outdoor fabrics are lined unglued, therefore any creasing in the upholstery is an inevitable consequence of use and cannot be considered grounds for any claims. To prolong the life of the product, clean the surfaces regularly, dry them with a clean cloth and remove any stagnant water, especially if exposed in locations with a high level of humidity or a marine climate.

When not in use, we recommend storing in sheltered places and covering with waterproof protection. In this case, it is advisable to remove the cover and ventilate the product frequently and regularly to avoid the onset of any mould or stains due to damp.
